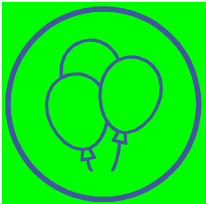

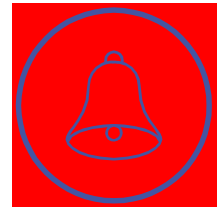

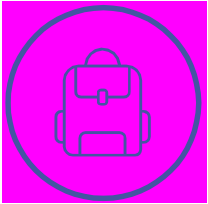

Sign up 8am - 2p, and then go directly out to the 3D course. 30 targets, All the ranges closed till 4:00.

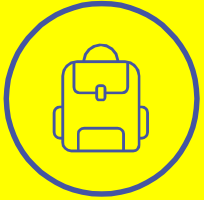

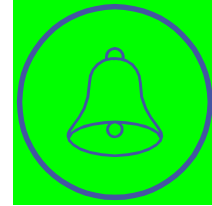
